## SKYTRANS ANNOUNCES NEW MOUNT ISA AND GULF SCHEDULES

Skytrans is pleased to announce that effective 26 July 2010, a new schedule will be introduced into and out of Cairns. Topping the list of changes is the increase in Mount Isa to Cairns services which will now operate on a daily return basis during the working week. Flights will depart Cairns in the morning and Mount Isa in the evening.

*"Skytrans continually seeks to gather input from passengers and key stakeholders with a view to fine tuning the Gulf schedule in order to accommodate the needs of the community as best we can"* said Simon Wild, Managing Director, Skytrans.

*"Additional services on Tuesdays and Wednesdays now mean that passengers can choose to travel in either direction any day during the week"* said Mr Wild.

Mount Isa passengers will also notice some positive changes with later departure times enabling connections through the Gulf ports to Cairns, Townsville and Brisbane to be more comfortably met.

*"Passenger levels have increased considerably since Skytrans assumed the remaining term of the Department of Transport and Main Roads subsets and in response to market demands, additional flights have been introduced"* added Steve Jones, Manager Commercial RPT.

Other changes to the schedule designed to benefit travellers to the Cape regions include additional services to Aurukun at the start and the end of the working week, and an upgrade to Coen flights which will now operate utilising the larger Dash 8 aircraft.
